Study Shows Quarry's New Location Safe for Wildlife

To meet the growing construction needs of north Alabama, Rogers Group's Limestone County Quarry, is planning to open a facility at the intersection of US Highway 31 and Laughmiller Road near Tanner, Alabama.

To address environmental concerns, an assessment conducted by the AST Environmental Group found that the proposed quarry activity would not affect the continued existence of protected species for Limestone County. This assessment has been submitted to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, Division of Water.

Placing a high value on being a good neighbor in the community, Rogers Group constantly explores methods of operation to minimize impact on surrounding ecosystems.

For over 50 years, Rogers Group has shown itself to be a good neighbor in north Alabama. Limestone County, in operation since 1999, recently received the prestigious Silver Excellence in Community Relations Award from the National Stone Sand & Gravel Association for its operation in Limestone County.
